The Republic of Serbia has received financing from the World Bank and European Investment Bank toward the cost of the Road Rehabilitation and Safety Project (the Project) and intends to apply part of the proceeds for consulting services.

The consulting services (“the Services”) include preparation of the technical documents in form of detailed designs for heavy maintenance (road rehabilitation-upgrading) of the state roads IA 1, IB 22 and IIA 147 for the following sections:

Lot 1: IA 1, Brestovac (interchange) - Doljevac (interchange), L= 6.903 km

Lot 2: IB 22, Ušće - Raška (Kosovska Mitrovica), L= 32.103 km

Lot 3: IB 22, Novi Pazar (Brđani) - Ribariće, L=24.360 km

Lot 4: IIA 147, Smederevska Palanka (Azanja) - Velika Plana, L= 13.532 km

The designs shall be prepared in accordance with requirements of the Client’s Terms of Reference and national legislation. The Consultant will be also expected to take into consideration the requirements of local community (social aspect) and shall act in full compliance with the requirements of the Resettlement Policy Framework and the Environmental Management Framework, which were developed for the project and are available on <http://www.putevi-srbije.rs/index.php/en/road-rehabilitation-and-safety-project>. The Terms of Reference for the Services are available on the same link.

Planned duration of the Services is 10 months.

The Public Enterprise “Roads of Serbia” (“the Client”) now invites eligible consulting firms (“Consultants”) to indicate their interest in providing the Services. Interested Consultants should provide information demonstrating that they have the required qualifications and relevant experience to perform the Services. The shortlisting criteria are: company profile, experience of the Consultant specific to the assignment and experience of the Consultant specific to the region (relevant references) within the last 7 years.
