## Contract Title: Procurement of Road Weather Information System (RWIS) equipment, software and training

- The Republic of Serbia has received financing from the World Bank toward the cost of the Road Rehabilitation and Safety Project (RRSP), and intends to apply part of the proceeds toward payments under the contract for **Procurement of Road Weather Information System (RWIS) equipment, software and training**. Bidding process will be governed by the World Bank's rules and procedures.
- 2. The **Public Enterprise ''Roads of Serbia''** (hereafter referred to as the **Purchaser**) now invites sealed bids from eligible bidders for **Procurement and installation of Road Weather Information System (RWIS) equipment, software and training.** The RWIS equipment consists of 60 Road Weather Stations (RWSt) to be fully installed on the state road network of the Republic of Serbia (16,000km) and connected with established Central Communication Server in Belgrade. CE Certification is requested together with warranty of 36 months. The complete RWIS equipment shall be delivered, and 5 (five) Road Weather Stations shall be installed and tested with provided training within 20 weeks upon the Contract signing.

The Bidder should meet the following qualification criteria:

- The Bidder must have at least five (5) years of experience in dealing with Road Weather Information Systems, as evidenced by a list of dates, purchasers, goods and values of the goods during the last five (5) years, i.e. in the period from 2014 to 2018.
- The Bidder must have at least two successfully completed contracts for supply of not less than 120 Road Weather Stations in total, during the period from 2014 to 2018. The Purchaser's References and contract information should be provided along with other information. If the Bidder is a Joint Venture (JV), all members of the JV should be jointly and severally liable for the contract implementation and should jointly meet all qualification requirements and each of the members of the JV should have at least one successfully completed similar contract for supply of not less than 60 Road Weather Stations during the period from 2014 to 2018.
- The Bidder shall have average annual turnover not less than the equivalent of EUR 3,000,000 during the years 2016, 2017 and 2018. If the bidder is a Joint Venture (JV), all members of the JV should be jointly and severally liable for the contract implementation and should jointly meet all qualification requirements. The average value of the business of member in charge should be at least the

equivalent of EUR 1,000,000. The bidders should submit photocopies of their official audited annual financial statements/auditor's reports for years 2016, 2017 and 2018;

- 3. Bidding will be conducted through the International Competitive Bidding procedures as specified in the World Bank's *Guidelines: Procurement of Goods, Works and Non-Consulting Services under IBRD Loans and IDA Credits & Grants by World Bank Borrowers* dated January 2011 (revised July 2014) ("Procurement Guidelines"), and is open to all eligible bidders as defined in the Procurement Guidelines. In addition, please refer to paragraphs 1.6 and 1.7 setting forth the World Bank's policy on conflict of interest.
