1. The Republic of Serbia has received financing from the World Bank toward the cost of the Road Rehabilitation and Safety Project (RRSP), and intends to apply part of the proceeds toward payments under the contract for **Procurement of Road Weigh In Motion (R-WIM) System equipment, software and training**. Bidding process will be governed by the World Bank's rules and procedures.
2. The **Public Enterprise "Roads of Serbia"** (hereafter referred to as the **Purchaser**) now invites sealed bids from eligible bidders for **Procurement of Road Weigh In Motion (R-WIM) System equipment, software and training**. The R-WIM System equipment consists of 4 (four) Road Weigh In Motion (WIM) Systems with solar power supply to be fully installed on the state roads IA category of the road network of the Republic of Serbia, with corresponding software and training. Components of the R-WIM System are requested to be CE certified. All components of the R-WIM System shall have a warranty period of 5 years (60 months) after installation. The complete R-WIM System equipment shall be delivered, and 4 (four) Road Weigh In Motion Systems with solar power supply shall be installed, calibrated and tested with provided training within 60 days following the date of effectiveness the Contract.

The Bidder should meet the following qualification criteria:

If Bidder is Manufacturer:

- The Bidder must have at least five (5) years of experience in dealing with Road Weigh In Motion (R-WIM) Systems, as evidenced by a list of dates, purchasers, goods and values of the goods during the last five (5) years, i.e. in the period from 2015 to 2019.
- The Bidder must have at least two (2) successfully completed contracts for supply of not less than eight (8) Road Weigh In Motion (R-WIM) Systems in total, during the period from 2015 to 2019. The Purchaser's References and contract information should be provided along with other information. If the Bidder is a Joint Venture (JV), all members of the JV should be jointly and severally liable for the contract implementation and should jointly meet all qualification requirements.
- The Bidder shall have average annual turnover not less than the equivalent of EUR 2,800,000 during the years 2017, 2018 and 2019. If the bidder is a Joint Venture (JV), all members of the JV should be jointly and severally liable for the

contract implementation and should jointly meet all qualification requirements. The average value of the business of member in charge should be at least the equivalent of EUR 700,000. The bidders should submit photocopies of their official audited annual financial statements/auditor's reports for years 2017, 2018 and 2019.

If Bidder is not manufacturer:

- If a Bidder is not a manufacturer, but is offering the Goods on behalf of the Manufacturer under Manufacturer's Authorization Form, the Manufacturer shall demonstrate the above qualifications and the Bidder shall demonstrate that it has successfully completed at least 2 (two) contracts of similar goods in the past 5 (five) years.
 - The Bidder must have at least two successfully completed contracts for supply of not less than eight (8) Road Weigh In Motion (R-WIM) Systems in total, during the period from 2015 to 2019. The Purchaser's References and contract information should be provided along with other information. If the Bidder is a Joint Venture (JV), all members of the JV should be jointly and severally liable for the contract implementation and should jointly meet all qualification requirements.
3. Bidding will be conducted through the International Competitive Bidding procedures as specified in the World Bank's *Guidelines: Procurement of Goods, Works and Non-Consulting Services under IBRD Loans and IDA Credits & Grants by World Bank Borrowers* dated January 2011 (revised July 2014) ("Procurement Guidelines"), and is open to all eligible bidders as defined in the Procurement Guidelines. In addition, please refer to paragraphs 1.6 and 1.7 setting forth the World Bank's policy on conflict of interest.

6. Bids must be delivered to the address below on or before **28 July 2020, 11:00 AM** (local time). Electronic bidding will not be permitted. Late bids will be rejected. Bids will be publicly opened in the presence of the bidders' designated representatives and anyone who choose to attend at the address below on **28 July 2020, 11:00 AM**.
 7. All bids must be accompanied by a **Bid Security** of **14,000 EUR**.
