This Invitation for Tenders follows the General Procurement Notice (9111-GPN-36651) for this project which was published on the European Bank for Reconstruction and Development (the Bank) website with the latest update provided on 23 May 2018.

The Public Enterprise “Roads of Serbia” hereinafter referred to as the “Employer”, intends using part of the proceeds of a loan from the Bank towards the cost of Belgrade Highway and Bypass Project.

The Employer now invites sealed tenders from contractors for the following contract to be funded from part of the proceeds of the loan:

- **LOT 9: Installation of Public Lighting on the IA State Road no.1, Section BT “Lasta”– “Bubanj potok”.**

During the construction of motorway E75 through Belgrade in previous century, the public lighting was installed along the entire section, except on subsection from BT "Lasta" to "Bubanj Potok", km 587+615.38 - km 592+166.96 (L=4.552km). The Contractor is expected to perform all Works on installation of public lightening on the mentioned subsection. The works on public lightening would significantly improve traffic safety on the section in front of the Toll Plaza.

The Works will be performed under traffic with a strong emphasis on maintaining safe conditions for both the flow of traffic and the works in progress.

Time for completion of Works is **150 days** followed by 3 years of DNP.

Tendering for contracts to be financed with the proceeds of a loan from the Bank is open to firms from any country.

To be qualified for the award of a contract, tenderers must satisfy the following minimum criteria:

### Financial requirements

- Submission of audited balance sheets or if not required by the law of the Tenderer's country, other financial statements acceptable to the Employer, for the last **three (3)** years to demonstrate the current soundness of the Tenderers financial position and its prospective long term profitability;
- Minimum average annual construction turnover of **EUR 3,000,000** equivalent, calculated as total certified payments received for contracts in progress or completed, within the last **three (3) years**;
- The Tenderer must demonstrate access to, or availability of, financial resources such as liquid assets, unencumbered real assets, lines of credit, and other financial means, other than any contractual advance payments to meet: (i) the following cash-flow requirement: **min. EUR 400,000 equivalent** and (ii) the overall cash flow requirements for this contract and its concurrent commitments.

### Experience requirements

- General experience - Experience under contracts in the role of contractor or management contractor for the last **three (3)** years prior to the tender submission deadline, and with activity in at least nine (9) months in each year.
- Specific experience:
  - (a) Participation as contractor or management contractor in at least **two (2) contracts** – Installation of public lighting on motorway or semi-motorway that is completed after 1<sup>st</sup> January 2008, where minimum value of the contractor's share for public lighting per contract must be at least **EUR 500,000** excluding VAT;
  - (b) For the above or other contracts executed during the stipulated period under item (a), a minimum experience in the following key activities: Installation of public lighting in total length of min. 1 km.

Above and all other qualification requirements related to the eligibility, litigation history, and technical capabilities are specified in the Section III. Evaluation and Qualification Criteria of the Tender Documents. Tender documents may be obtained from the office at the address below upon payment of non-refundable fee of **EUR 200 (two hundred euros)** or equivalent in a convertible currency.
